Action research training / planning workshop; Base-line data collection in 6 locations to ensure reliable outputs from the action research. Publication of draft STAR guidelines 3 x National-level training workshops with Pamoja support (facilitated by globally recognised "experts" in Reflect and SS),
Jan-March 2005	 Facilitator recruitment and training in each of the 6 pilot locations (10 communities with approx 3 circles in each so up to 30 facilitators in each pilot). 6 x Action Research Coordinators orientate facilitators in action research – key indicators, documentation and learning processes etc, Compilation of STAR guidelines in each country /location based on the local adaptations of the approach 60 STAR groups started in each country, enabling participants in sex / age groups to analyse a full range of local development issues in the light of HIV. Groups will meet regularly at times of their own choosing and the different peer groups in each community will occasionally meet together. These groups will engage in a wide range of activities (see below)
